#### **MEETING NOTES**

- 1. Introductions and welcome
  - RSK is the newest member of the EWG and Jessica and Huong joined the meeting in Hanoi.
- 2. <u>GEFE British Pavilion and EWG's "Team UK" approach / proposals</u> update, Tobey, Hugh, Ray
  - Eurocham organised GEFE on 21-23 October 2024 in HCMC.
  - DBT offering space in UK Pavilion to UK companies at a subsidised rate.
  - EWG suggested fitting up a 9sq.m "Team UK EWG" booth to demonstrate the breadth of energy companies
  - EWG aiming to secure sponsorship from 15+ members;
    confirmed interest at the meeting: Minh Tam, IMPAC,
    Perygrene, Freshfields, BE-CIS, RSS, ... and will talk to others.
- Roof-Top Solar (RTS) from BE-CIS, Thanos (Thuan) and Heidi Refer to slides issued. Other notes:
  - BE-CIS introduced their team and also Huawei, their battery storage contractor.
  - They outlined the scope of energy solutions across Electricity Generation, Thermal Generation and Energy Efficiency, with Energy as a Service, where solution providers invest in the solution, providing energy services to clients.
  - As well as securing some UK finance, BE-CIS has BritCham members, such as Coates as their client. Some EWG members indicated interested in visiting a client location.
  - Denzel indicated ADB (PIC tech. assistance) will publish a report on what legal reform is needed to enable energy service companies such as BE-CIS to pursue more growth.
     Note: revisions for the Law on Energy Efficiency, with MoIT committee to this, with efficiency a Government priority.
  - BE-CIS client list, mostly MNC. Any reason why there is no local group? 2021 enter Vietnam and focus on MNC with strong credit check, but Vietnamese clients anticipated.
  - BE-CIS Huawei partner visitors introduced their large company and scope. Last few years shipped >50GWh BESS.

  - Look to "join the dots" and pursue some business as well as just talking .... Some B2B discussion. [Ray]
  - Day out at an Industrial Park / Zone perhaps a "show piece" project. [Ray, Thanos]

  - All members to contact Long directly and update.
  - Discussed moving the Membership list to the webpage and keeping it updated monthly.
