

SNAPSHOT OF VIETNAM'S ECONOMY



Vietnam GDP Annual Growth Rate (Until Q1 2024) - TRADING ECONOMICS

According to the General Statistics Office of Vietnam, Vietnam's economy is on a strong upswing, with Q2 2024 recording a robust 6.93% year-on-year growth, the fastest pace since late 2022. This growth, exceeding the revised Q1 figure and pushing the expansion streak to 11 quarters, is fueled by booming exports and strong performances in services, industry, and construction. While agriculture maintains its positive trajectory, the first half of 2024 saw a 6.42% jump in GDP, the second-highest H1 performance in recent years. The government aims for 6-6.5% growth in 2024 despite external risks, aligning with the IMF's projection of 5.8%. To achieve this target, Prime Minister Pham Minh Chinh emphasizes flexible policies like lower interest rates and increased public investment.

In contrast, Standard Chartered Bank's global research report, titled "Vietnam – Ql GDP to moderate amid rising inflation", the bank hit the brakes on Vietnam's 2024 GDP forecast, revising it down to 6% from a previous prediction of 6.7%. This adjustment stems from a lackluster first quarter and concerns about global trade winds shifting direction. This still shows solid growth.

THE ICT POTENTIAL BETWEEN THE UK & VIETNAM



According to VietnamPlus, in a workshop promoting cooperation opportunities with Vietnamese technological firms was held in London on June 14, 2023, Vietnamese Ambassador to the UK Nguyen Hoang Long (now Vietnam's MOIT Deputy Minister), expressed his hope that technology will be a key focus of collaboration between the two countries over the next five years, especially in areas such as digital health, financial centers, and financial technology.

Deputy CEO of techUK Antony Walker highlighted that the UK's growing focus on the Indo-Pacific region and its membership in the CPTPP trade agreement make cooperation with Vietnam across all levels - government, specific sectors, national development, and business - more crucial than ever.

In addition, Debby Davidson, co-founder and COO of Acclime, believes Vietnam's push for digital transformation, combined with the strong demand from UK tech firms to make similar transitions, will make Vietnam a very appealing destination for British businesses in the coming five years.

Mohan Naidu, the head of FPT Software's UK branch, emphasized Vietnam's strengths as a rising center for innovation:

- Vietnam possesses impressive annual graduation rate of **57,000 IT students**
- Vietnam has become the world's second-fastest growing digital economy in 2022, and is expected to take the top spot this year.
